



























Siding Penetration Request Form



Subcontractor must fill out and submit all required cells in order to get a penetration cut through the siding.























CUB 2 – EXTERIOR/ROOF











Inspections

- This is a reminder regarding inspections on our site.
- There are items like MEWP, scaffolds, forklifts, etc., which are examples of equipment or surfaces that require a visual inspection every day before starting work.
- Work in the area can only begin after a successful inspection and approval (checklist).
- Of course, there are other items, such as electrical tools, which
 require an inspection by a certified electrician every three
 months. However, a visual inspection must still be conducted
 every day before using the equipment.
- It is essential to adhere to these procedures and remember that there is personal responsibility for the operators of the various tools.
